Windfarms – General

Two new windfarms in scoping/proposed:

Craiginmoddie – 16T upto max 230m in height – basically in area of ex-Hadyard Hill Extension – Energie Kontor.

Artfield Forest – 20T 180m in height, in scoping adjoins existing Artfield near New Luce – Scottish Power Renewables - ECU00002042.

Other ones being talked about – North and South Kyle, Knockodhar

Per headings below, as a reminder:

Carrick Forest – 17T upto 200m high – ECU00002063 – in scoping, SPR, leaflet being sent out to residents and some commercial

Arecleoch Extension – 13T plus associated infra – refused by SAC.

Linfairn – no new info.

Tralorg – BayWa r.e. – construction resumed 11 May.

Lamboughty – no further info.

Kirkhill – planning extension granted to 2022.

Kilgallioch – Extension being scoped.

Chirmorie – passed for 22T

Altercannoch – refused on appeal for 8T by reporter.

Millenderdale – SAC refused for 5T.

Glenapp – no additional info.

Mark Hill substation extension – does this mean more turbines?

Hadyard Hill – turbine number 44 or 45 has been removed.

Clauchrie – our objection was submitted 27 February to the Consents Unit: ECU 00002001.

If members of the community have any comments regarding proposed windfarms, they should make their views, whether positive or negative, known to the CC as soon as possible, or direct them straight to the planning application.
