Dalquharran grounds have been opened up as Alex Paton indicated in his letter. Further clearing is taking place, please be careful and aware of forestry work.

Wind Farms – General

Scoping is being carried out on Carrick and Craiginmoddie Wind Farms – our responses will be sent to the Energy Consents Units at the appropriate time. Still trying to obtain information regarding – Knockodhar in the Stinchar Valley. Per headings below, as a reminder:

Craiginmoddie – 16T upto max 230m in height – basically in area of ex-Hadyard Hill Extension – Energie Kontor – ECU00002080.

Carrick Forest – 17T upto 200m high – ECU00002063 – in scoping, SPR, leaflet has been sent out, a larger map will be forwarded for the Notice Board, a response has been made for the Scoping.

Arecleoch Extension – 13T plus associated infra – refused by SAC, SPR resubmitting. **Kirk Hill** – planning extension granted to 2022 – requesting an increase in height from 110

to 115.5m – appealing Energy Consents Unit – PPA-370-2086.

Clauchrie – our objection was submitted 27 February to Consents Unit - ECU 00002001.

Tralorg – BayWa r.e. – construction resumed 11 May, not yet energized.

Lamboughty – no further info.

Linfairn – no new info.

Kilgallioch – Extension being scoped.

Chirmorie – passed for 22T

Altercannoch – refused on appeal for 8T by reporter.

Millenderdale – SAC refused for 5T.

Glenapp – no additional info.

Mark Hill substation extension – does this mean more turbines?

Hadyard Hill – turbine number 44 or 45 has been removed.

South Kyle – approved.

Artfield Forest – 20T 180m in height, in scoping adjoins existing Artfield near New Luce – Scottish Power Renewables (SPR) - ECU00002042.

If members of the community have any comments regarding proposed windfarms, they should make their views, whether positive or negative, known to the CC as soon as possible, or direct them straight to the planning application.
