4. Wind Farms – General  
Per headings below (have taken away ones that have not been updated recently):  
New windfarm application: **Knockcronal** – in Scoping – ECU00002181 – deadline 26 February – please advise any comments. Basically ex-Linfairn 12T up to 200m to tip.  
**Clauchrie** – Consents Unit - ECU00002001 (ref 074). SAC formally objected. Now going to Public Inquiry – DPEA – WIN-370-3 – it will be possible to watch the proceedings.  
**Craigimoddie** – amended to 14T upto max 200m in height – basically in area of ex-Hadyard Hill Extension – Energie Kontor – ECU00002080 – on-line public event available - <https://www.energiekontor.co.uk/our-projects/craigimoddie> - sent in a couple of comments, and have now been made aware of the full consultation ECU00002196 – will be asking for an extension to end March. Please note that the Heavy Load access is proposed off Eldinton Terrace. There are issues particular with turbines 1,2,3,4, and 5 re potential water contamination, noise and/or visual.

**Carrick Forest** – reduced to 13T upto 200m high inc Energy Storage System – ECU00002063 –scoping response sent. Recreational Enhancements indicated, and Online Public Information Event held. SPR have now sent info re Community Investment if consented to build. This needs to be discussed/consulted on. SPR sent a ‘Gatecheck Report’ in response to our EIA Scoping response. Various Questions answered.

**Arcleoch Extension** – 13T plus associated infra – now in Public Enquiry.

**Kirk Hill** – planning extension granted to 2022 – appeal granted height now 115.5m.

**Tralorg** – operational since 21 October. Waiting for info from HMRC, funds available after this, still to organise paper trail issues and evaluations of distribution.

**Knockodhar** – 32T tip height upto 200m inc Energy Storage System. South side of Stinchar Valley. In Scoping ECU00002153 – sent response 27 November.

The result of the flyer/leaflet distribution showed that the majority of the community were not in favour of any more windfarms. This was explained on the Facebook page in mid-December. Please keep an eye out for Notices in the various Newspapers regarding any windfarm consultations in this area. (During discussions after Zoom, it was decided to send a note to Cllrs, MP, MSP – Secretary to compose and send to CC members for approval).

**If members of the community have any comments regarding proposed windfarms, they should make their views, whether positive or negative, known to the CC as soon as possible, or direct them straight to the planning application.**

#### 5. Paths / Dailly Trails and Dalquharran

We should now seriously think how we can best use our portion of the £25,000.

Still checking the most suitable locations for the self-closing gates. JF suggested putting down hard core together with drainage pipe in areas where there might be damaged wooden boardwalks – these rot away too quickly and have chicken wire that breaks-down.

#### 6. Hadyard Hill Community Fund Panel and Small Grant Fund

Unanimously approved Zoom meeting minutes of 7 December – JW, PW, HM, FdF, JW by email. Secretary will advise CG/FS. JW had received documentation re establishment of endowment fund, would sign and return to CG/FS.

PW advised that at 18 January Panel meeting, a point was raised about an Entertainment sub-group to bring forward and implement ideas. CC members thought this was a great idea and should be discussed with the Community Association.

Small Grants Fund – none. A member of the community suggested that maybe some funding could be put towards laptops for the School. This would be checked.

#### 7. Roads / Potholes / Gully Pots / 20 mph consultation

Waiting for more detail re one-way system at Hadyard Terrace – there would probably be some form of monitoring/consultation. Re 20-30mph speed limit road improvements – going to Regulatory Panel for approval, most probably flashing signage.

ARA provided salt/grit for the bins over the cold snap – it is apparent that we probably need more salt bins. The question is where – we also need volunteers for Winter Resilience.

Secretary had asked for certain lights to be upgraded and for gully pots to be cleared – please comment if there are any issues.

JW advised of the constant flooding at the Kilkerran Station turnoff even after the resurfacing, and the issue of poor drainage along Eldergrove/Maxwelston section of road. The state of the Back Road was again highlighted – Cllr AC to discuss with ARA.

#### 8. Councillor's Report

Cllr AC indicated that the current main concern was the Budget – the position was tight, and services had been affected; there might have to be charges for certain services.

Cllr AC advised that SAC would investigate the state of repair required for the Miners Memorial lighting. He also advised that the Legal Dept was checking the status of the Plot behind the School.

Cllr AC advised that we should be receiving notification of Postponement of CC Elections, until further notice. Secretary asked whether potential members could be co-opted – check MW/SAC.

#### 9. Other Points

*Brunston Clubhouse* – PW questioned Planning Refusal to allow the change of use to a private dwelling. Members were in agreement that there was no obvious reason for refusal. Members were also in agreement that a letter of support could be issued if needed. JW/Secretary to check status.
