3. Minutes of Previous Meeting

5. Wind Farms – General  
Per headings below (have taken away ones that have not been updated recently):  
**Clauchrie to Knockodhar overhead lines** – SPR have put forward a consultation re OHL, they have not sent this directly to Daily CC - deadline 21 June. They are looking at Screening options now, this will then probably go to ECU in Summer 21 to see if an EIA is required, then Section 37 – basically the government will push through.  
**Knockcronal** – Scoping – ECU00002181 – response lodged - ex-Linfairn 12T up to 200m. All households should have received a leaflet from Statkraft re their preliminary consultation – deadline 25 June. The proper consultation through the ECU is still to happen.  
**Clauchrie** – Consents Unit - ECU00002001 (ref 074). SAC formally objected. Public Enquiry – DPEA – WIN-370-3 – huge amount of work by local objectors. Available to view on web live.  
**Craigmoddie** – reduced to 14T up to max 200m – basically ex-Hadyard Hill Extension – Energie Kontor – ECU00002080 – <https://www.energiekontor.co.uk/our-projects/craigmoddie> - sent in comments. Full consultation ECU00002196 – response was

*submitted to ECU. SAC will send in their response by about September. Heavy Load access proposed off Eldinton Terrace/Issues particular with T1,2,3,4, and 5 re potential water contamination, noise, visual, overbearing, shadow flicker.*

**Carrick Forest** – reduced to 13T up to 200m inc Energy Storage System – ECU00002063 – scoping response sent. Recreational Enhancements indicated, and Online Public Information Event held. SPR have now sent info re Community Investment if consented to build. This needs to be discussed/consulted on. SPR sent a ‘Gatecheck Report’ in response to our EIA Scoping response. Various Questions answered.

**Arcleoch Extension** – 13T plus associated infra – Public Enquiry – DPEA – WIN-370-2 – now with Reporters to prepare for Scottish Ministers.

**Kirk Hill** – planning extension granted to 2022 – height now 115.5m.

**Tralorg** – operational since 21 October 2020. Awaiting update – Companies House/HMRC needed further info.

**Knockodhar** – 32T tip height up to 200m inc Energy Storage System. South side of Stinchar Valley. In Scoping ECU00002153 – sent response 27 November.

**If members of the community have any comments regarding proposed windfarms, they should make their views, whether positive or negative, known to the CC as soon as possible, or direct them straight to the planning application.**

#### 6. Paths / Dailly Trails and Dalquharran

JF had met with local fencer and was awaiting quote. She was also meeting soon with AP/Dalquharran and Balcarnie to discuss possibilities at the Drumburle side, and to look at the Waulkmill Bridge to see whether it was feasible to make any circular route.

FdF advised that RT had walked the Hadyard route through Craig Farm – there appears to be an electric fence issue – JW to investigate. She also advised that some of the paths (Quarry Walk) were rather overgrown – Cllr AC suggested the Community Payback Team – Secretary to check.

#### 7. Roads / Potholes / Gully Pots / 20 mph consultation

On-going – waiting for info re one-way system at Hadyard Terrace. Waiting for update on the 20-30mph improvements – however Cllr AC indicated that the installation was moving forward in various villages, and Dailly is on the list. There would be limited hard engineering with the road narrowing at the Bridge at Andy Lunny, otherwise flashing signage/lining.

Secretary spoke with Eddy McCulloch/ARA re siting of salt/grit bins. We have 3 in situ (Woodside, Church Crescent, Victory Crescent). Do we have any suggestions for others – Drs/Brae/Colemans, Smiths Crescent? Indicated that we would decide by August, and use the ARA website.

Members indicated to Cllr AC that Back Road was appalling – has more patches than road. He advised that he would ask KB/ARA if the repairs schedule could be brought forward.

Secretary is in the process of completing the CARES application with the Local Energy Scotland Development Officer. Should know by mid-end June whether we will receive funding. As indicated on an email sent to members, we need to organise a Steering Group to carry this forward – between 3 and 5 people. They will be involved with LES DO to help form criteria for a consultant through the Invitation to Tender, to evaluate and then manage the consultant. PW and FdF indicated that they would like to help – it would be good to have another 1 or 2 others.

FdF advised that she had received a Thank You from the Rural, they had made good use of their grant. There were no SGF applications.

Land Energy was expanding a lot at Grangestone with an additional 3 lines - this was a good opportunity for local employment.

The long-awaited MUGA looks set to be built at Victory Park, Girvan at a cost of approx. £900,000.

The appeal for Brunston conversion to a dwelling house had been passed.

Cllr AC advised that the closing date for funding for Summer Activities was 3 June.

*Carrick Activity Centre* – had been used as a vaccination and asymptomatic testing centre, and would again be used from 7-13 June. Has been open for over a month and getting good response from membership. Classes sometimes outside when weather is good. Football and badminton up and running again.
