3. Minutes of Previous Meeting
Minutes of 03 November 2021 were proposed by RT and seconded by NB.

4. Police Report

5. Speaker – Ryan Douglas – SAC/Team Leader/Sports Hub based in Girvan
RD introduced himself, and indicated that the ethos of the Health and Wellbeing Team was to develop sport and activity opportunities from birth right through to retirement and beyond. They are trying to promote activities in all local villages with opportunities for all ages. He will be completing a consultation with both primary and Secondary schools to identify community needs. Several new officers have been employed to help achieve this. Monday

Madness at the Activity Centre is one of the current programmes offered within Dailly. The Active Schools coordinators now sit within the wider Thriving Communities Team.

6. Matters Arising

Community Association

NB advised that the scheduled meeting did not take place. Generally the Association was trying to re-energise the group, re-do the constitution and looking to find ways of reducing costs. The Christmas Lights would be up shortly – there was a thought to potentially change the Light Company. JW also advised that the Christmas Tree will probably be available w/c 13 December.

Place Planning

Several members attended the Place Planning meeting on 17 November. Discussion and participation was informative. The results of the survey are not yet available. It has been agreed that the Place Planning and CAP will share info.

7. Wind Farms – General

ET gave a rundown of the situation with Craiginmoddie - Energy Consents Unit has advised the deadline for consultation on Additional Information. The main points to bear in mind are Private Water Supply Infrastructure, Access Road, Hydrologist providing ‘indicative’ catchment info, Peat Slide Hydrology (Scot Gov commissioned Ironside Farrar, conflict of interest?), flawed info re Noise Surveys, turning-off of turbines under certain wind conditions, overbearing nature (additional 200m over actual land). ET advised that Arecleoch Extension had been approved.

Per headings below (have taken away ones that have not been updated recently):

Clauchrie to Knockodhar overhead lines – SPR - *waiting ECU advice.*

Knockcronal – Scoping – ECU00002181 – response lodged - ex-Linfairn, now 9T up to 200m, and 3T up to 180m. Awaiting proper consultation through the ECU. Public Event was held on 21 Sep. Also at Straiton. *Stratkraft/ECU advise consultation deadline 02 February – Secretary to ask for extension.*

Clauchrie – Consents Unit - ECU00002001 (ref 074). SAC formally objected. Public Enquiry – DPEA – WIN-370-3 – is now with the Reporter – a lot of controversy.

Craiginmoddie – reduced to 14T up to max 200m – basically ex-Hadyard Hill Extension – Energie Kontor. Full consultation ECU00002196 – response submitted to ECU. SAC will respond by about Sep. Various meetings between certain outlying residents and Energie Kontor/SAC and others. *Additional Information consultation – deadline 13 December – Secretary requested extension/granted 14 January 2022.*

Carrick Forest – reduced to 13T up to 200m inc Energy Storage System – ECU00002063 – scoping response sent. *Nothing new.*

Areacleoch Extension – 13T plus associated infra – Public Enquiry – DPEA – WIN-370-2 – *has been approved.*

Kirk Hill – planning extension granted to 2022 – height now 115.5m.

Tralorg – operational since 21 Oct 2020. Still waiting on Companies House/HMRC – *meeting on 9 December re how to proceed and distribute funds.*

Knockodhar – 32T tip height up to 200m inc Energy Storage System. South side of Stinchar Valley. In Scoping ECU00002153 – sent response 27 Nov 2020.

Scienteuch – new wind farm, have not received anything officially – ECU00003318 – 9T, up to 200m – basically Lamdoughty and Keirs Hill, NE of Straiton, S of Patna.

If members of the community have any comments regarding proposed windfarms, they should make their views, whether positive or negative, known to the CC as soon as possible, or direct them straight to the planning application.

8. Paths / Dailly Trails / Dalquharran / Brunston

JF indicated that self-closing gates were being installed during weekends. No additional info re culverts and Waulkmill Bridge.

No further info re HDH/Bargany about boundaries. Nor about Dalquharran.

There was general discussion on the path from the Pump House by the School around Memorial Park to the Fish Bridge, how to make better use of and how to clear away excess vegetation. Secretary to contact AP/Dalquharran.

9. Roads / Potholes / Gully Pots / 20 mph consultation

Cllr AC received info from ARA re scheduled work on drainage/ditches around Eldergrove/Maxwelston, together with completion of temporary Give Way signage at Andy Lunnie Bridge. Concerns were also raised about water flowing off the fields at Moorston Cottage, and at Kilkerran – Cllr AC to check.

ARA advised that an additional Salt Bin will be located at the bottom of Drs Brae.

10. Hadyard Hill Community Fund Panel and Small Grant Fund

NB advised that next Panel meeting will be 13 December. Secretary read out the reply from Clare Graham/FS re our request to increase the Small Grant award to £1,000 - SSE agreed to an increase to £650. After discussion amongst members, it was agreed that PW would again raise the issue at the Panel meeting.

PW advised as at 25 November, Endowment Fund was £53,181 with the FS Builder at £876.

There were no applications for the SGF. In general discussion, once the Community Association was constituted, they could act as a grant conduit for various groups using the Community Centre.

11. Community Action Plan

It was really important to ensure that as many people as possible attend the event.

12. Community Council Elections

Chris Campbell (new Link Officer) and Cllr AC both indicated that elections would commence 10 January 2022, and terminate on 31 March 2022 – using the New Scheme. We will receive info soon.

For sake of good order, Secretary needed to confirm that NB was indeed co-opted as at 01 September – proposed RT, seconded PW.

13. Carrick Activity Centre

HM advised that 2 instructors were being PVGd for 12-18yr olds using gym under free access. The Low Impact style classes had commenced – needed more participants.

14. Councillor's Report

Cllr AC provided a plan for the Plot behind the School – a few questions arose re the access off Colemans (gradient), access from the car park to the School, whether a charging point might be included, and whether the Head Teacher had been consulted. Cllr AC checking.

Guardian at Grangestone – nothing new to report – on-going.

15. Treasurer's Report

FdF advised: Paths a/c: £2,001.56, DCC a/c: £17,683.81 (includes gates grant) – 2 x £500 grants taken out.
